



SOBIR is a 4 session education/intervention program developed through a partnership between the Cleveland County Health Department and the Cleveland County School System.

### Who can attend?

#### Referrals are made:

- By the school as an alternative to suspension
- By parents and/or agency staff who feel an intervention is appropriate for a student

### What are these sessions?

#### Session 1: Student and Parents

Bio/Psycho/Social Screening- The student and parent/guardian are interviewed and information is gathered by the assigned health educator.

#### Session 2: Student

SASSI (Substance Abuse Subtle Screening Inventory) is administered to the student by a SASSI certified health educator and education is given.

#### Session 3: Student

SASSI results shared and continued education/intervention information given. Goal setting with student and future plans are discussed.

#### Session 4: Student and Parent

Assessments shared with parents. SOBIR contract is presented and discussed. Referrals for additional services if necessary.

### How do I complete the program?

#### To complete the program the student and parent/guardian must:

- Attend all 4 sessions with the health education staff as scheduled
- Pay Assessed Fees (\$50 initial fee; additional sessions billed on a sliding scale.)

Failure to attend all sessions and/or pay all fees will result in a noncompliance notice being sent back to the student's school.
