
Cleveland County Register of Deeds and Cleveland County Veterans Services Veterans Appreciation Program

One of the responsibilities of the Register of Deeds office is to record Veterans' DD214 - Military Discharge papers in Cleveland County. In October 2016, the Cleveland County Register of Deeds Office, launched a program in cooperation of the Veterans Services Officer, Debra Conn, encouraging Veterans to record their DD 214's. "Thank a Veteran for Service" cards are issued confirming eligibility to receive discounts or incentives from participating Cleveland County businesses when presented. Cleveland County businesses can participate in this program by simply going to our website and completing the merchant application, or completing the form below and returning to us by mail or email. If a business is currently offering discounts or incentives, add the information to the list. A current list of participating businesses is on the Cleveland County Register of Deeds website at www.clevelandcounty.com/rod/vets. Veterans who record or have previously recorded their DD 214's in our office are directed to our website for a list of participating businesses or given a printed list upon request.

A decal will be sent to participating businesses for display, indicating participation in the "Thank a Veteran for Service" program. This will also show appreciation to Veterans for their service to our Country.

The Cleveland County Register of Deeds, with the support of Cleveland County Veteran Services, is providing Veterans "Thank a Veteran for Service" Cards that entitle them to a discount or incentive at local participating businesses. We would like to offer you an opportunity to show your appreciation to Veterans by participating in the program. The "Thank a Veteran for Service" Card is a requirement to qualify for any discount or incentive.

Enrollment is for a year with an annual automatic renewal. A 30 day written notice is required to withdraw. Discounts may be a percentage of the sale or a specific dollar amount (both can be with restrictions), if applicable or you may want to offer an incentive (gift or gift card) to the Veteran.
