# How Does This Impact My Wallet?

Current Sales Tax in Cleveland County is 6.75%. If approved, the new tax rate would be 7.00%.

**How much more will I pay?**

- \$0.25 per \$100
- \$1.25 per \$500
- \$2.50 per \$1000

*This tax does not apply to commonly purchased items like groceries, gasoline, prescription drugs and motor vehicles. It also does not alter property taxes.*
