Letter from the Director

Since 2020, the library has celebrated significant achievements in reinventing our spaces and starting new programming initiatives. Our staff in partnership with many community organizations, have been able to create spaces and provide programming opportunities not previously offered in Cleveland County. We've worked with Cleveland County and the Friends of the Library to construct a new Access Services point, a Teen Space, renovated the children's rooms at both the Eugenia H. Young Memorial Library and the Spangler Branch, created the first Makerspace in the city of Shelby, and a renovation and rebranding of the Genealogy room to the North Carolina room.

In the Winter/Spring of 2025, we will be relaunching bookmobile/mobile library service in Lower and Upper Cleveland County for the first time in over a decade. The new mobile library will offer customers access to Wi-Fi, the use of laptop computers for workforce development, and a mobile Makerspace with a 3D printer, Cricut Vinyl cutter, and craft supplies.

We look forward to the new opportunities the mobile library will provide for us to connect with the entire community. We are honored to have served all residents of Cleveland County over the last 50 years, and we

are excited for the next three years.
