

PERMIT CHECKLIST

1. Environmental Health Permit: * Fees as of July 1, 2022, subject to change

Existing Septic Inspection: \$175, Good for 6 months.

 \Box "PERC" Test (No septic yet): \$450, Good for 5 years.

2. Zoning Permit: (Need before picking up full Septic Tank Approval and getting the Building Permit.)

□Zoning: \$60, Good for 1 year.

3. Residential Building Permit: (Pole Buildings require engineer drawings.) *Fees as of July 1, 2020

Depending on whether you are building a house or purchasing a mobile home, the following items will be required to obtain a permit.

Building a new home, addition or Modular Construction. You will need the following:

A copy of your Environmental Health Authorization to Construct.
Zoning permit if required

Subcontractors and their license numbers

□Lien Agent information obtained from <u>www.liensnc.com</u> if the job is over \$40,000.

Permits may be issued to the homeowner, but the NC General Statutes require that the homeowner occupy the home for a minimum of 12 months after the certificate of Occupancy is issued. Also, will have to fill out a homeowner's exemption affidavit. It is advisable to have your building contractor obtain your permit.

Fees (as of July 1, 2020)

Single Family Dwelling: Fee is based on Size-

□ Finished Space: Finished square footage x .87 x .548

 $\hfill\square$ Unfinished Space: Unfinished square footage x .87 x .548 x .25

Double or Single Wide Manufactured Home: \$300

□Accessory Structure, under 400 Sq. Ft.: \$125

□ Accessory Structure, over 400 Sq. Ft.: \$200

□Swimming Pool: \$125
