SPECIAL RECOGNITION

RECOGNITION OF CHAIRMAN JOHNNY HUTCHINS

Commissioners and staff members took a moment to thank Commissioner Johnny Hutchins for serving as Chairman in 2011 and 2012. Commissioner Hutchins was presented a plaque with his gavel in appreciation of his hard work and dedication as chairman.

REGULAR AGENDA

SALE OF TAX FORECLOSURE PROPERTY-324 BUFFALO STREET

Tax Administrator, Chris Green presented Parcel #17375 for approval of sale. Property was obtained through tax foreclosure in 2007. A bid of \$2,280 was received from Larry Hosch through the sealed bid process. In researching the property, Mr. Hosch discovered an outstanding tax lien with the City of Shelby for \$1,560. The City of Shelby has agreed to accept \$780 to satisfy the lien.

At their December 2, 2008 meeting, Commissioners adopted Tax Foreclosure Property Guidelines. Mr. Green made note, these were guidelines only. The county has \$3,929.86 invested in the property. The current tax value is \$2,400. Sale was properly advertised by the County Clerk. Mr. Green recommended the sale of the property as follows:

APPOINTMENT OF TAX COLLECTOR

Effective February 28th, 2013, Linda Wiggins will retire from her appointed position as Tax Collector.

Per N.C.G.S. 105-349 the governing body of each county shall appoint a tax collector for a term to be determined by the appointing body and until his or her successor has been appointed and qualified. The governing body shall appoint as tax collector a person of character and integrity whose experience in business and collection work is satisfactory to the governing body, and, who shall furnish bond conditioned upon his honesty and faithful performance.

Tax Administrator Chris Green recommended and requested Commissioners consider the appointment of Necole Richard as Tax Collector, effective March 1st, 2013.

Necole has over 13 years experience in the collection of property tax; 8 ½ of those with Cleveland County. She has worked under Mr. Green's supervision since consolidation of the Tax Department in 2005. In that time he has found Necole to be a person of character and integrity. He has received written confirmation of approval for issuance of personal bond from the county's insurer.

<u>ACTION:</u> Johnny Hutchins made the motion, seconded by Jason Falls and unanimously adopted by the board, to appoint Necole Richard as tax collector effective March 1, 2013 with no term expiration.

CLOSED SESSION

<u>ACTION:</u> Chairman Hawkins called for Commissioners to conduct a closed session regarding a legal matter, as allowed under North Carolina General Statute 143-318.11(a)(3).

COMMISSIONER REPORTS

Commissioner Holbrook and EDC staff have been working hard on Project X-Cel. The project continues to move forward. Project Phoenix is also being worked on.

Commissioner Hutchins attended the RPO meeting. He was concerned with some of the numbers presented. They are continuing to work on MPO boundaries. He has received several calls regarding fire service in the upper end of the county.

Commissioner Falls attended a Partners board meeting. He is faced with a challenge regarding Cleveland County's representation on the board. The state will be determining board representation. He suggested writing a letter to the state regarding this.

There is much sickness in the nursing homes throughout the County. Commissioner Falls asked that we remember these people in our prayers.
