## **COUNCIL ON AGING LOAN REPAYMENTS**

County Manager David Dear received a letter from the Council on Aging requesting their payments of \$14,000 annually for loan approved by Commissioners be lessened to \$7,000 annually. The balance of the loan is \$56,000. Approval would extend payments to June 30, 2021.

# <u>TRANSPORTATION ADMINISTRATION OF CLEVELAND COUNTY (TACC): RURAL OPERATING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (ROAP) APPLICATION</u>

Bob Davis, TACC Director, stood before Commissioners requesting approval of the ROAP application. This year TACC will be requesting a total of \$231, 751. The application contains various programs including: Elderly & Disabled Transportation Assistance Program (EDTAP), Employment Transportation Assistance Program (EMPL) and Rural General Public Program (RGP).

The FY14 ROAP individual program totals are:

Mr. Davis explained, this money is used for those citizens who do not have Medicaid. TACC is exploring the feasibility of making a stop in the Fallston/Lawndale area a few times a day.
